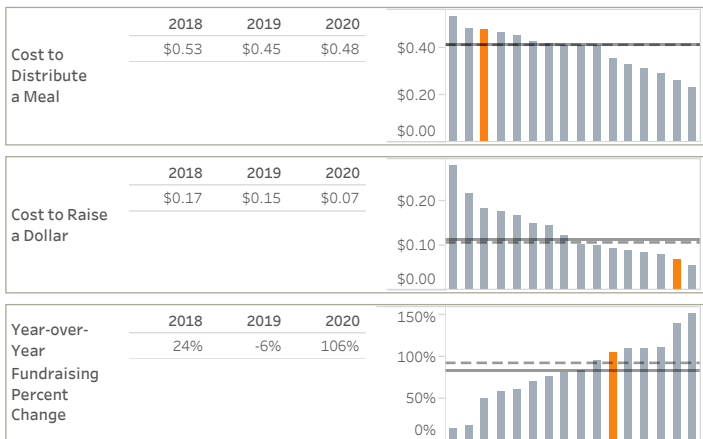

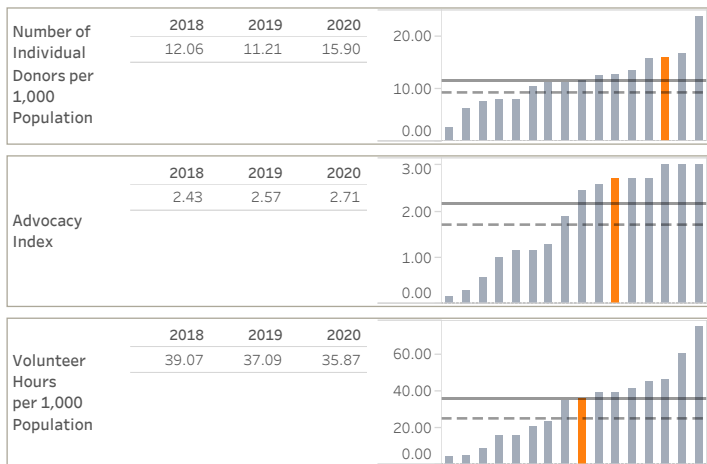

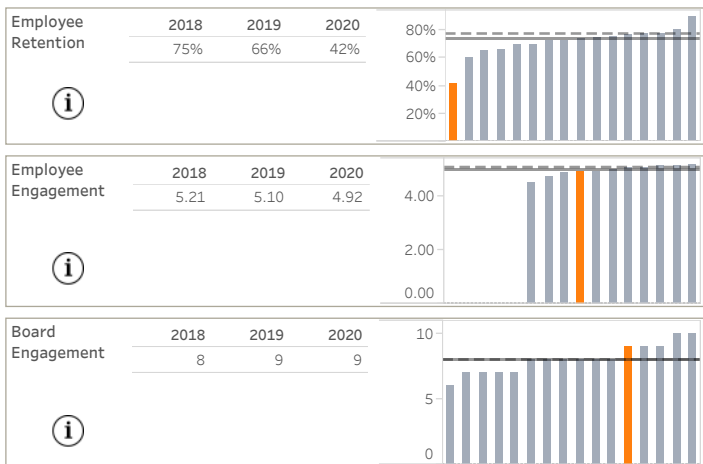

Solid line = peer group median

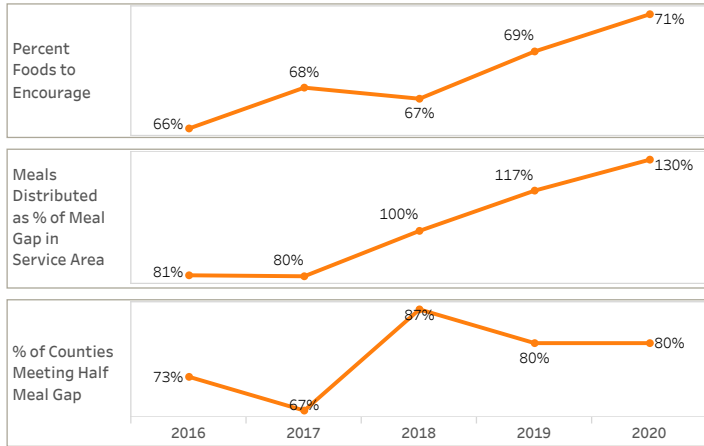
Dotted line = network median

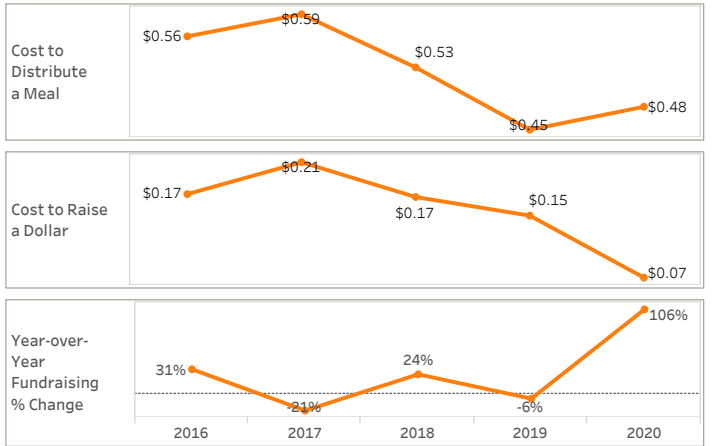

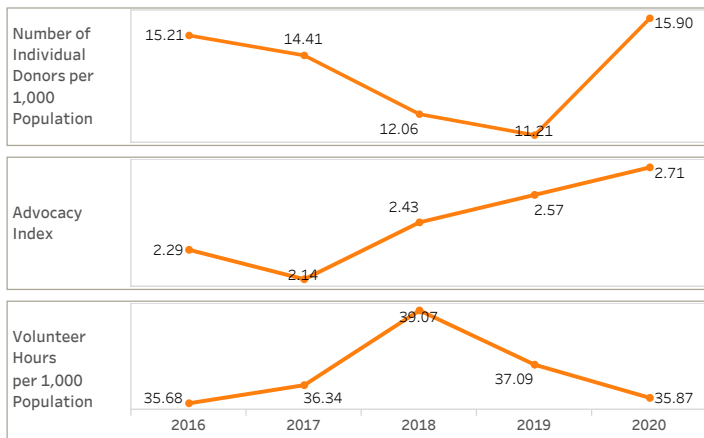

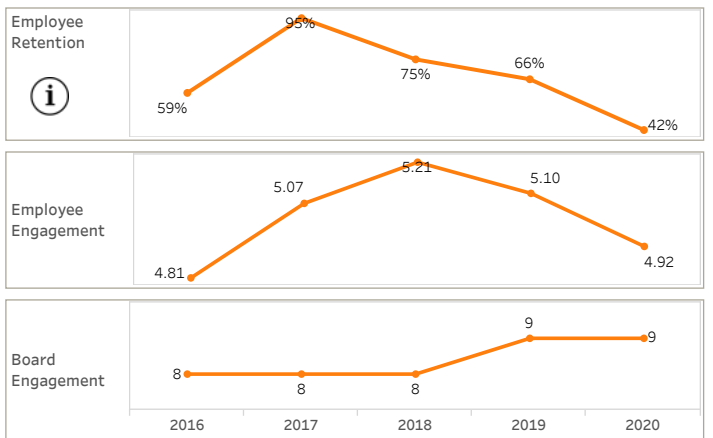

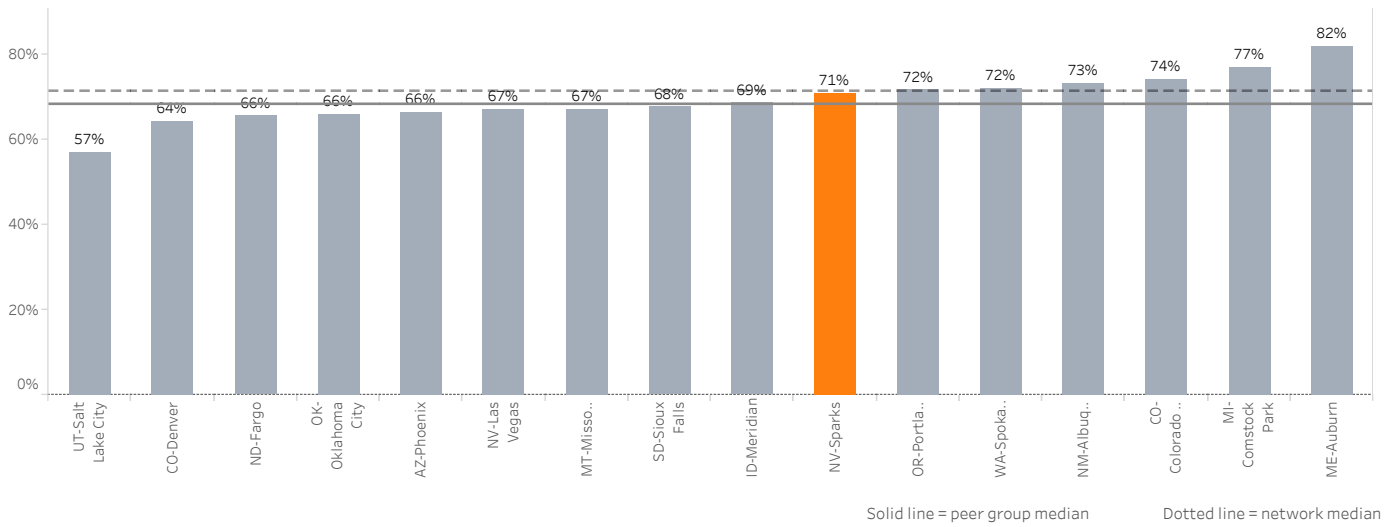

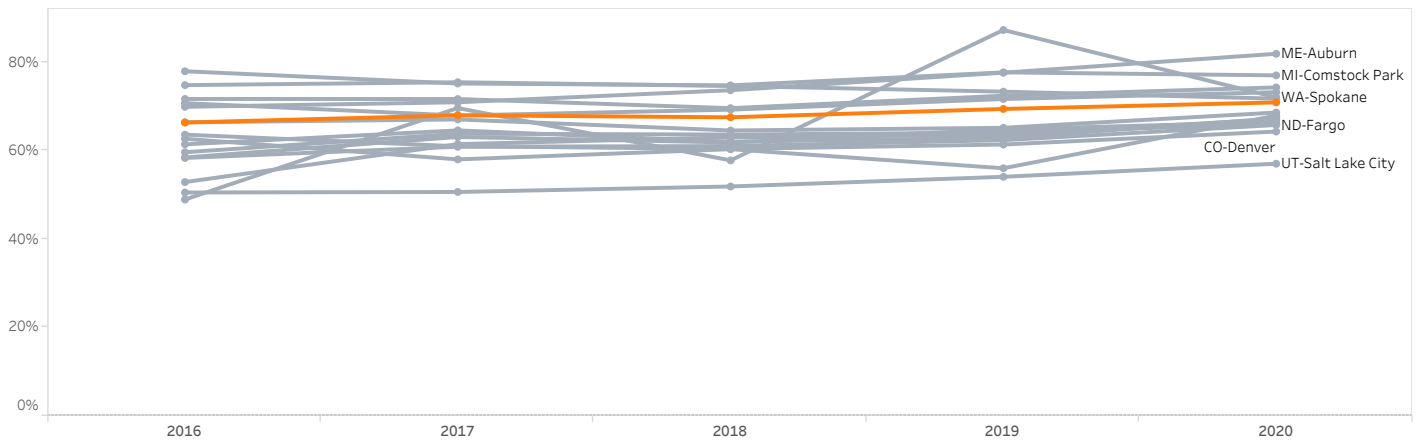
