Neighbors Share Food Access Challenges and Needs

Toward the end of FY2025, the Food Bank began conducting listening sessions with neighbors from across our service area. These sessions were designed as intentional spaces to engage deeply with community members, ensuring that their voices, perspectives, and lived experiences inform how we approach food access and related services. Food Bank staff wanted to better understand needs and barriers around food insecurity and access and to more clearly identify the root causes of food insecurity.

Through open dialogue, participants shared both the practical challenges they face—such as transportation, language barriers, limited access to fresh and culturally relevant foods, and inconsistent pantry hours—as well as the emotional impact of navigating food insecurity. Importantly, these conversations revealed instances where neighbors felt welcomed and supported but also highlighted gaps in services and areas where equity, dignity, and accessibility are lacking.

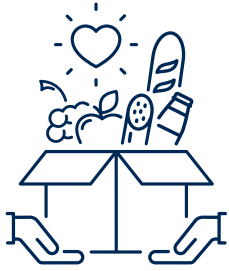
The insights gathered are now helping guide our Service Area Assessment, ensuring that any future adjustments to programs, partnerships, or resource distributions are community-informed and responsive to actual needs.

Focus on the Future for Our Community

The Food Bank initiated a strategic planning process the last half of FY2025 to set the direction for the organization for the next 5-10 years. After a comprehensive RFP and selection process, CoSpero Consulting was selected to lead the planning process because of their exemplary work with Feeding America on the network strategic framework and strategic planning with other food banks and nonprofit organizations. The initial phase of the planning, which began at the end of FY2025, includes gathering input from staff, board, partner agencies, neighbors, donors, and other community stakeholders. A new strategic plan will emerge along with a plan for execution and accountability in FY2026.

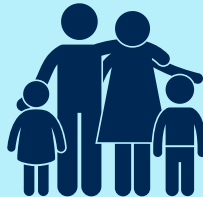

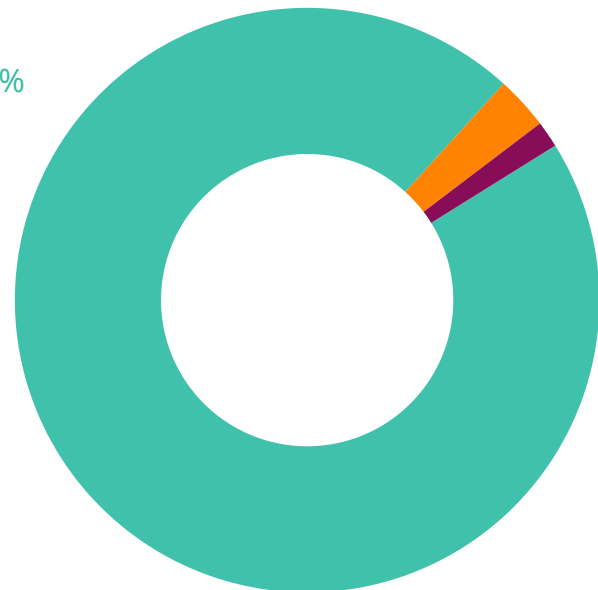

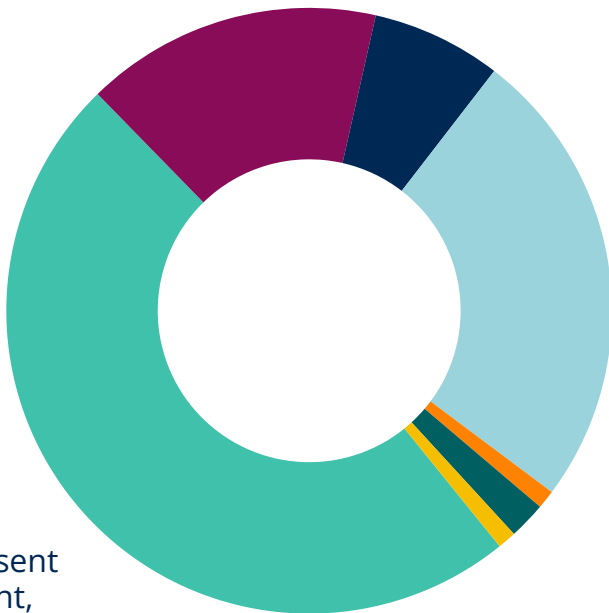
